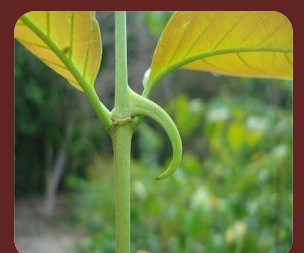
UNCARYL
